Curriculum

- **Religion**—All four years. Hebrew Scriptures, New Testament, Life in Christ, Ecclesiology, Death & Resurrection, Social Justice, Jesus in Christian Faith, and Building Loving Relationships. St. John's University credit available in Senior year.
- **English** — All years have honors level courses available, as are AP English Literature, AP English Language, Communication for College, and Film as Art.
- **Social Studies** — Global History and Geography 9 & 10, US History and Government, Economics, Government, AP US History, Law, Anthropology, & Psychology. Honors Global (2 years -3 semesters). Honors Economics and Government for MSJF Scholars.
- **Fine Arts/Practical Arts — Music:** Music Appreciation, Vocal Ensemble, Select Chorus, Form & Analysis. **Art:** Visual Perception, Major Art I,II, III, Photography. **Computer:** Orientation, Research On-Line, Think Quest, ICT, Computers for HS, College.edu. **Physical Education:** All years, plus PE Leaders. **Etiquette** for Professional Women. **Health** as required by NYS.
- **Mathematics** — Integrated Algebra, Geometry, Intermediate Algebra & Trigonometry with Honors-level available. Pre-Calculus, Calculus, Advanced Topics in Mathematics, Quantitative Reasoning may be elected. AP Statistics and AP Calculus are distance-learning electives.
- **Science** — Living Environment, Earth Science, Chemistry and Physics. Honors Biology, Chemistry and Physics available. Electives include Marine Science, Forensic Science, Human Biology, AP Biology and Advanced Genetics (MIT).
- **World Languages** — Three years of Spanish, Italian and Latin in preparation for the NYS Comprehensive Regents Examination. Accelerated instruction in Italian and Spanish leading to SJU credit and AP curriculum. Multimedia instruction.

Each year, the top 10% of first and second choice applicants to **Fontbonne** are named **MSJF Scholars**. They have achieved a score at the 90th %ile or above on the TACHS exam and have outstanding 6th -8th-grade academic records including standardized test scores. MSJF Scholars are eligible for scholarships and incentive awards if Fontbonne is their first choice.

MSJF Scholars may receive honors placement in English, Social Studies, Science and Mathematics. Students who excel in World Language studies will be accelerated after their first year.

Fontbonne knows you are special and will design an academic program that fits your talents, preparing you for a successful college experience and beyond. The college process begins on the first day of Freshman year and continues until the day you are admitted to college. At Fontbonne, you will find a school small enough to let you be YOU, but large enough to provide a challenge and a host of exciting electives.
